A three-day 'Deep Dive' residential workshop focuses on self-awareness, reflection and social intelligence skills that build trust and rapport between participants. Personal and team action learning projects put new skills into practice. Two follow-up residential workshops are codesigned with participants.

Online modules, coaching and mentoring activities maintain connections and progress in-between workshop sessions.
