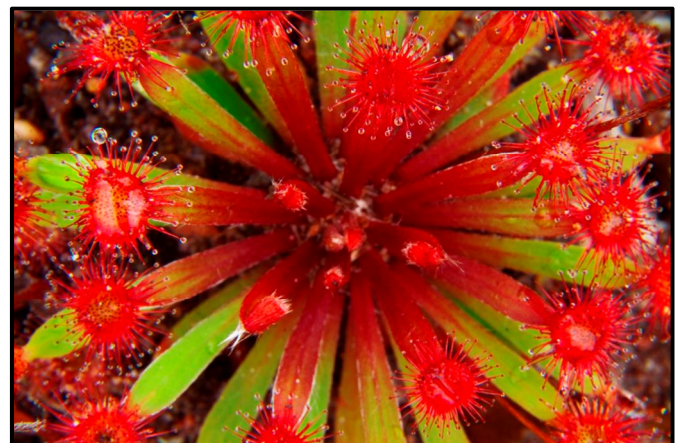

Venue: River Rd Reserve (refer map overleaf)

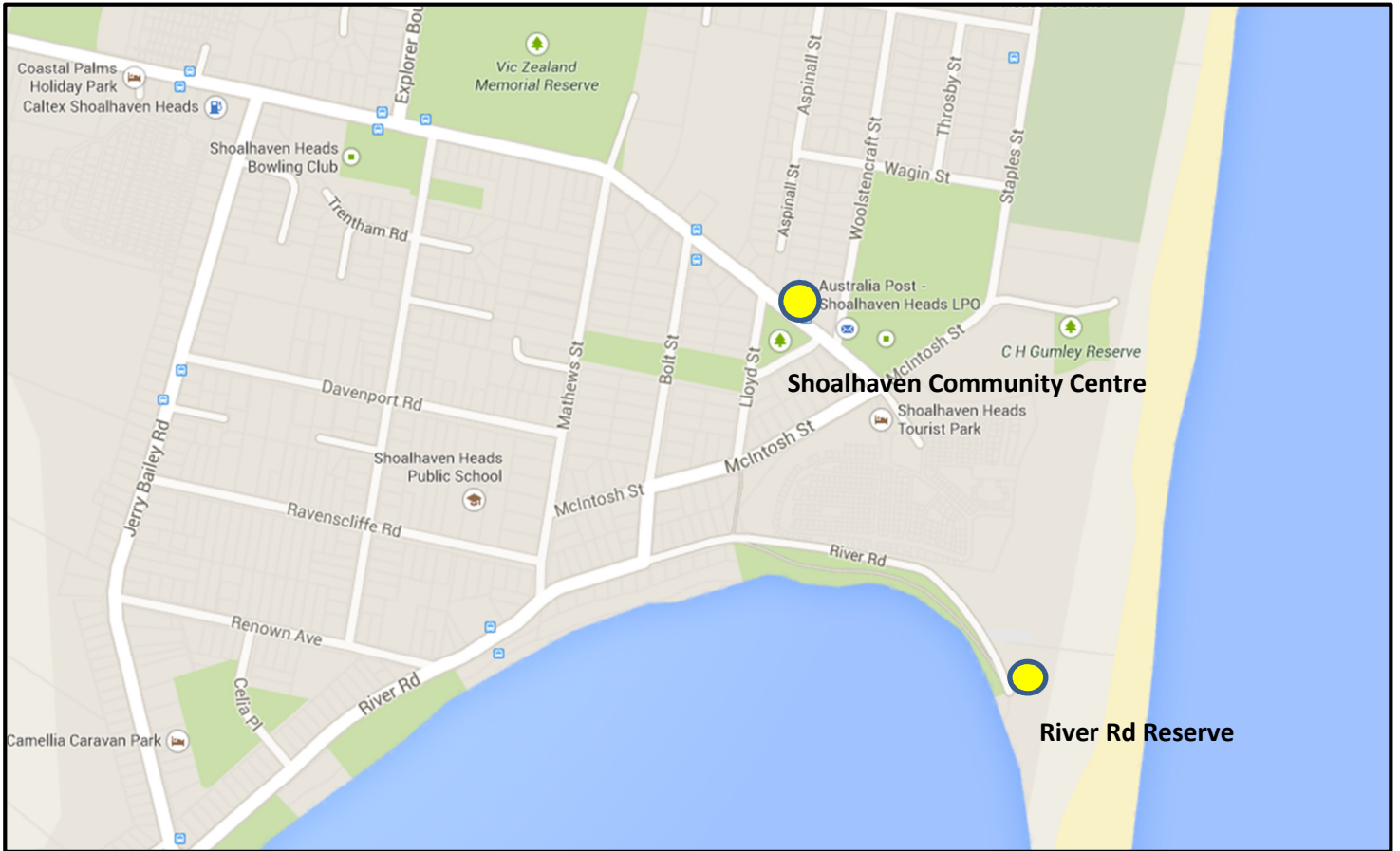
What to bring: Hat, sunscreen, water,
