This Strategic Plan will guide Landcare Illawarra's activities over the period 2024-



About us



Landcare Illawarra is a community-based organisation that helps the Illawarra community living in the three local government areas of Wollongong, Shellharbour and Kiama on the NSW South Coast to get involved in a broad range of environmental repair activities. We support local groups restoring biodiversity on public and private land between the Royal National Park and Seven Mile Beach, and collaborate with partners including private landholders, state and local governments (including Councils' natural area volunteer groups), and not-for-profit organisations. Landcare Illawarra is part of the South East Landcare federation. In collaboration with our partners, we provide a diversity of support services to help people to look after our local environment. Together, we share resources, collaborate on projects, and build skills in order to use the best practices we can to restore the Illawarra landscape.
